

Pool Rules

For your health and safety all pool rules will be enforced. If you have any questions regarding pool rules please see Michael Alonzo, Aquatics Coordinator or a member of the Aquatics Committee.

1. Follow lifeguard directions at all times
2. Appropriate swimwear is required
3. No boxers, cut-off shorts, basketball shorts or thongs
4. No running
5. No smoking
6. No floats or rafts - Only U. S. Coastguard approved floatation devices
7. No diving in restricted areas
8. No diving into water less than 9 feet deep
9. No rough play
10. No sitting on shoulders, flicking towels, pushing or dunking
11. No glass containers in pool area
12. No food outside snack bar area
13. This includes candy & gum
14. No deep cuts, sores or open wounds in pool
15. Swim diapers required
16. ALL children under the age of 8 MUST be accompanied by an adult with in arms reach
17. No water guns

Diving Well

1. No personal floatation devices or floatation suits in diving area
2. No diving or swimming in diving area while boards are in use
3. Divers must be able to swim the width of the pool
4. One person on the board at a time
5. Dive only from the front of the board, not the sides
6. Divers must swim immediately to the ladder and exit before the next diver may dive
7. No one is allowed to catch or wait for divers who are jumping

Lily Pads

1. Must be able to reach the rope from the deck with no assistance and without having to jump to grab it.
2. Only one person at a time on the lily pad walk
3. Each person must be standing when going across the lily pads
4. No running, sliding, kneeling, or sitting while going across the lily pad walk
5. Must use the ropes
6. If you fall, you must exit the area immediately
7. Begin the lily pad walk from the side closest to fence
8. No swimming in the lily pad area

Slides

1. Must be at least 48” tall NO EXCEPTIONS, even if you know the child can swim
2. No personal floatation devices or floatation suits allowed
3. Must sit or lay on back in a feet first position
4. One person at a time
5. No one on the slide until previous rider is at the side of the catch pool
6. Maximum weight is 300 pounds
7. No glasses, goggles or jewelry allowed around neck or in pockets
8. Enter the slide in a sitting position
9. No standing to propel down slide

Waterama

1. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult with in arms reach
2. No diving

Lap Lanes

1. Lap swimmers only
2. Please follow proper swimming etiquette when sharing a lap lane
3. No floatation devices or floatation suits in lap lanes
4. No swimming under the lap lanes to exit the pool

Adult Therapy Pool

1. Must be at least 14 years of age
2. 15 minute time limit
3. No jumping or diving
4. People who suffer from a chronic medical condition should consult their physician before using the therapy pool

Violations of any of the above rules may result in restrictions from participation
